Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 34 be introduced, AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ARTICLE VIII ENTITLED "OFFENSES CONCERNING PROSTITUTION" OF CHAPTER 215 ENTITLED "OFFENSES" OF TITLE II ENTITLED "PUBLIC HEALTH, WELFARE AND SAFETY" OF THE TRENTON CITY CODE, which was read. Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 34 be passed to the second reading placed upon final passage and voted on. Motion carried. A copy of Bill No. 34 was made available for public inspection prior to this meeting by being posted at City Hall on May 10, 2019. The following vote was taken. NEW BUSINESS

Megan Derry and Micah Landes were present to discuss a day pass for food trucks for a business license. It was recommended by Councilmember Crawford to charge \$15.00 for the day pass.

Motion by Councilmember Smith second by Councilmember Mlika to set up a \$15.00 per day rate for food trucks in the downtown area as designated by the Historic committee and revisit this after 12 months. Motion carried with Councilmember Briggs voting no. City Attorney Walker will draw up an ordinance and bring it back at the next council meeting.

Motion by Councilmember Briggs second by Councilmember Fisher to leave the electric rates as they are now through summer. Motion carried.

Discussion was held concerning a rate study for electric. Motion by Councilmember Briggs second by Councilmember Smith to send out an RFQ for a rate study with a presentation of what we will get for the study. Motion carried with Councilmember Fisher, Brewer and Chumbley voting no.

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City Attorney Walker went through training for the Mayor and council.

Motion by Councilmember Briggs second by Councilmember Chumbley to adjourn at 8:30 p.m. Motion carried.
