### BILL NO. 5

Motion by Councilmember Briggs second by Councilmember Brewer that Bill No. 5 be introduced, AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI APPROVING AN AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI AND ANIXTER, INC., FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A COMMUNICATION SYSTEM COMPRISED OF EQUIPMENT AND SOFTWARE PROVIDING TWO-WAY COMMUNICATION WITH UTILITY METERS AND OTHER DEVICES IN THE CITY OF TRENTON AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK OF THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI, TO EXECUTE THE SAME BY AND ON BEHALF OF SAID CITY, which was read. #### BILL NO. 6

Motion by Councilmember Smith second by Councilmember Briggs that Bill No. 6 be introduced, AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 400.565, "ACCESSORY USES" OF ARTICLE XI ENTITLED "PERMISSIBLE USES" OF CHAPTER 400 ENTITLED "UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE" OF TITLE IV ENTITLED "LAND USE" OF THE TRENTON CITY, which was read. Motion by Councilmember Smith second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 6 be passed to the second reading placed upon final passage and voted on. Discussion was held. Motion carried.
