MINUTES

Motion by Councilmember Mlika second by Councilmember Crawford that the minutes of April 8, 2019 be approved. Motion carried.

BILLS

Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Briggs that all duly obligated bills for the City be paid. Motion carried.

REPORTS

A report was given by City Administrator Ron Urton.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Jason List from Strategy was present to explain his company. The council approved a contract at the last council meeting for IT work.

BILL NO. 19

Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 19 be introduced, AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI APPROVING AN AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI AND RAPID REMOVAL DISPOSAL, INC. FOR RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK OF THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI, TO EXECUTE THE SAME BY AND ON BEHALF OF SAID CITY, which was read. Motion by Councilmember Chumbley second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 19 be passed to the second reading placed upon final passage and voted on. Motion carried. A copy of Bill No. 19 was made available for public inspection prior to this meeting by being posted at City Hall on April 18, 2019. The following vote was taken. BILL NO. 20

Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 20 be introduced, AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI APPROVING AN AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI AND M&M UTILITIES, LLC FOR THE NORMAL STREET SEWER REHABILITATION PROJECT IN THE CITY OF TRENTON AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK OF THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI, TO EXECUTE THE SAME BY AND ON BEHALF OF SAID CITY, which was read. Motion by Councilmember Chumbley second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 20 be passed to the second reading placed upon final passage and voted on. Motion carried. A copy of Bill No. 20 was made available for public inspection prior to this meeting by being posted at City Hall on April 18, 2019. The following vote was taken. Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 21 be introduced, AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 160.020 ENTITLED "MEETINGS, RECORDS AND VOTES TO BE PUBLIC - EXCEPTIONS" OF ARTICLE I ENTITLED "IN GENERAL" OF CHAPTER 160 ENTITLED "OPEN MEETINGS AND RECORDS POLICY" OF TITLE I ENTITLED "GOVERNMENT CODE" OF THE TRENTON CITY CODE, which was read. Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 21 be passed to the second reading placed upon final passage and voted on. Discussion was held. Motion carried. A copy of Bill No. 21 was made available for public inspection prior to this meeting by being posted at City Hall on April 18, 2019. The following vote was taken. Ayes: Brewer, Chumbley, Smith, Mlika, Crawford, Dolan, Briggs and Fisher. Said bill was declared duly passed, numbered Ordinance No. 2019-21, signed and approved by the Mayor and attested by the City Clerk.

BILL NO. 22

Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 22 be introduced, AN ORDINANCE ENACTING A NEW SECTION 160.080 ENTITLED "HEALTH CARE COORDINATION – CERTAIN RECORDS MAY BE RELEASED" OF ARTICLE II ENTITLED "LAW ENFORCEMENT ARREST REPORTS AND RECORDS INCIDENT REPORTS, ETC." OF CHAPTER 160 ENTITLED "OPEN MEETINGS AND

RECORDS POLICY” OF TITLE I ENTITLED “GOVERNMENT CODE” OF THE TRENTON CITY CODE, which was read. Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 22 be passed to the second reading placed upon final passage and voted on. Discussion was held. Motion carried. A copy of Bill No. 22 was made available for public inspection prior to this meeting by being posted at City Hall on April 18, 2019. The following vote was taken. Ayes: Smith, Mlika, Crawford, Dolan, Briggs, Fisher and Brewer. Naye: Chumbley. Said bill was declared duly passed, numbered Ordinance No. 2019-22, signed and approved by the Mayor and attested by the City Clerk.

BILL NO. 23

Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 23 be introduced, AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 215.1370 ENTITLED “PATRONIZING PROSTITUTION” OF ARTICLE VIII ENTITLED “OFFENSES CONCERNING PROSTITUTION” OF CHAPTER 215 ENTITLED “OFFENSES” OF TITLE II ENTITLED “PUBLIC HEALTH, WELFARE & SAFETY” OF THE TRENTON CITY CODE, which was read. Discussion was held.

Motion by Councilmember Fisher second by Councilmember Brewer to table Bill No. 23 since it is covered under state law. Motion carried.

BILL NO. 24

Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Briggs that Bill No. 24 be introduced, AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 215.1530 ENTITLED “CERTAIN OFFENDERS NOT TO BE PHYSICALLY PRESENT OR LOITER WITHIN 500 FEET OF A CHILD CARE FACILITY – VIOLATION- PENALTY” AND SECTION 215.1540 ENTITLED “CERTAIN OFFENDERS NOT TO BE PRESENT WITHIN 500 FEET OF SCHOOL PROPERTY, EXCEPTION – PERMISSION REQUIRED FOR PARENTS OR GUARDIANS WHO ARE OFFENDERS, PROCEDURE” AND ENACTING A NEW SECTION 215.1530 ENTITLED “CERTAIN OFFENDERS NOT TO RESIDE WITHIN ONE THOUSAND FEET OF A PROPERTY LINE OF A SCHOOL, CHILDCARE FACILITY, OR VICTIM’S RESIDENCE” OF ARTICLE IX ENTITLED “SEXUAL OFFENSES” OF CHAPTER 215 ENTITLED “OFFENSES” OF TITLE II ENTITLED “PUBLIC HEALTH, WELFARE & SAFETY” OF THE TRENTON CITY CODE, which was read. Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 24 be passed to the second reading placed upon final passage and voted on. Discussion was held. Motion carried. A copy of Bill No. 24 was made available for public inspection prior to this meeting by being posted at City Hall on April 18, 2019. The following vote was taken. Ayes: Mlika, Crawford, Dolan, Briggs, Fisher, Brewer, Chumbley and Smith. Said bill was declared duly passed,

numbered Ordinance No. 2019-24, signed and approved by the Mayor and attested by the City Clerk.

BILL NO. 25

Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 25 be introduced, AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 300.010 ENTITLED "DEFINITIONS" OF CHAPTER 300 ENTITLED "GENERAL PROVISIONS" OF ARTICLE III ENTITLED "TRAFFIC CODE" THE TRENTON CITY CODE, which was read. Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 25 be passed to the second reading placed upon final passage and voted on. Motion carried. A copy of Bill No. 25 was made available for public inspection prior to this meeting by being posted at City Hall on April 18, 2019. The following vote was taken. Ayes: Crawford, Dolan, Briggs, Fisher, Brewer, Chumbley, Smith and Mlika. Said bill was declared duly passed, numbered Ordinance No. 2019-25, signed and approved by the Mayor and attested by the City Clerk.

BILL NO. 26

Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 26 be introduced, AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 310.070 ENTITLED "SIRENS AND FLASHING LIGHTS EMERGENCY USE-PERSONS AUTHORIZED-VIOLATION-PENALTY" OF CHAPTER 310 ENTITLED "ENFORCEMENT AND OBEDIENCE TO TRAFFIC REGULATIONS" OF TITLE III ENTITLED "TRAFFIC CODE" OF THE TRENTON CITY CODE, which was read. Motion by Councilmember Smith second by Councilmember Mlika to take this to the administrative committee. Motion carried.

BILL NO. 27

Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 27 be introduced, AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 340.127 ENTITLED "OPERATION OF AUTOCYCLES" OF CHAPTER 340 ENTITLED "MISCELLANEOUS DRIVING RULES" OF TITLE III ENTITLED "TRAFFIC CODE" OF THE TRENTON CITY CODE, which was read. Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 27 be passed to the second reading placed upon final passage and voted on. Motion carried. A copy of Bill No. 27 was made available for public inspection prior to this meeting by being posted at City Hall on April 28, 2019. The following vote was taken. Ayes: Briggs, Fisher, Brewer, Chumbley, Smith, Mlika, Crawford and Dolan. Said bill was declared duly passed, numbered Ordinance No. 2019-27, signed and approved by the Mayor and attested by the City Clerk.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Discussion was held concerning the asbestos flooring at the water plant.

Discussion was held concerning John Danks property on Crowder Road.

Discussion was held concerning why people have to have a building permit when constructing a sidewalk. Motion by Councilmember Briggs second by Councilmember Mlika to take this to the administrative committee. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS

Councilmember Chumbley said he is the liaison to the park board and they were asking if the City could give them help with the electric bill for heating the pool. The water has to be 70 degrees before they can open the pool.

Motion by Councilmember Briggs second by Councilmember Crawford to take the park board's request to the utility committee. Motion carried.

Jeff Barnard and Anthony Mravunac with Burns & McDonnell were present to discuss the sewer headworks issue. Jeff said the plans are 60% complete and they have bought some equipment for the headworks building.

Councilmember Crawford said we are talking about taking \$1 million out of the sewer plant expenses and financing \$3 million. We need to check with Charlie Zitnik and see if we can refinance the \$2.4 million COPS money that has a higher interest rate.

Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Chumbley to check into the funding for this project. Motion carried.

Discussion was held concerning raising the animal license fee from \$5.00 to \$20.00 or \$25.00. No action was taken.

City Administrator Urton said we received 3 bids for demolition of structures around the 17th street bridge. He stated he would recommend going with Perkins Dozing for \$75,000.00.

Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika to award Perkins Dozing the bid for the 17th street demolition project contingent upon MoDOT's approval. Motion carried.

Discussion was held concerning the scada services. City Administrator Urton said he received 2 bids. RS Electric and Pro Circuit which we have used both companies.

Motion by Councilmember Mlika second by Councilmember Crawford to approve RS Electric for the primary vendor and Pro Circuit for the back up. Motion carried with Councilmember Briggs voting no.

Motion by Councilmember Briggs second by Councilmember Crawford to approve the Mayor's appointment to Administrative, Finance and Economic Development committees and various boards. Motion carried.
