Absent: Councilmember John Dolan.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE AND PRAYER

At this time the Pledge of Allegiance was recited by everyone present. A prayer followed the pledge.

MINUTES

Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika that the minutes of July 8, 2019 be approved. Motion carried.

BILLS

Motion by Councilmember Chumbley second by Councilmember Brewer that all duly obligated bills for the City be paid. Motion carried.

REPORTS

Reports were given by Councilmember Crawford, Councilmember Briggs and City Administrator Urton.

IMPROVEMENTS ON ROUTE 6 IN THE CITY OF TRENTON AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK OF THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI, TO EXECUTE THE SAME BY AND ON BEHALF OF SAID CITY, which was read. Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 59 be passed to the second reading placed upon final passage and voted on. Discussion was held. Motion carried. Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 60 be introduced, AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI APPROVING A CONTRACT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI AND MISSOURI HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FOR RELINQUISHMENT OF A PORTION OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM IN THE CITY OF TRENTON AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK OF THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI, TO EXECUTE THE SAME BY AND ON BEHALF OF SAID CITY, which was read. Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 60 be passed to the second reading placed upon final passage and voted on. Discussion was held. Motion carried. A copy of Bill No. 60 was made available for public inspection prior to this meeting by being posted at City Hall on July 19, 2019. The following vote was taken. NEW BUSINESS

Discussion was held concerning the RICE NESHAP recertification testing. Motion by Councilmember Mlika second by Councilmember Crawford to accept the low bid of \$19,850.00 from Power Plant Compliance. Motion carried.

City Administrator Urton said we received 2 bids for the north airport hangar rental bids. Steve Hammond bid \$276.00 per month and David Tolen bid \$285.00 per month. Motion by Councilmember Mlika second by Councilmember Smith to accept the bid from Tolen Flying Service for \$285.00 per month. Motion carried with Councilmember Brewer voting no.

Discussion was held concerning the airport capital improvement plan. Motion by Councilmember Mlika second by Councilmember Fisher to move forward with the

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engineering for new hangars for the airport. Motion carried with Councilmember Brewer and Chumbley voting no.

Discussion was held concerning the use of the old R-9 building. City Administrator Urton said he would like to put in 1 or 2 overhead doors and use the building for storage of equipment. Each door would cost about \$5,500.00. He will talk to Micah Landes about the mixer and baking items.

Councilmember Mlika suggested seeing how much storage we need.

Motion by Councilmember Mlika second by Councilmember Brewer to table storage needs until we find out more information. Motion carried.

Motion by Councilmember Briggs second by Councilmember Crawford to sell or work something out with Micah about the equipment that is in the building. Motion carried.

Motion by Councilmember Chumbley second by Councilmember Brewer meeting adjourned at 8:32 p.m. Motion carried.
