Absent: Council members William Fisher, Cathie Smith and John Dolan.

### PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE AND PRAYER

At this time the Pledge of Allegiance was recited. A prayer followed the pledge.

Danny Shuler and Travis Elbert with Boy Scout Troop 97 brought boys from the troop that were working on a citizen badge. Each boy introduced themselves.

### MINUTES

Motion by Councilmember Briggs second by Councilmember Mlika that the minutes of October 28, 2019 be approved. Motion carried.

### BILLS

Motion by Councilmember Chumbley second by Councilmember Crawford that all duly obligated bills for the City be paid. Motion carried.

### REPORTS

Reports were given by Councilmember Crawford, Councilmember Mlika, Councilmember Briggs and City Administrator Urton.

Kelly Beets with MIRMA presented certificates for a grant that was given the City for a police camera and electrical crimpers.

### BILL NO. 78

Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Briggs that Bill No. 78 be introduced, AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 400.045 ENTITLED "DEFINITIONS" OF ARTICLE II ENTITLED "DEFINITIONS" OF CHAPTER 400 ENTITLED "UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE" OF TITLE IV ENTITLED "LAND USE" OF THE TRENTON CITY CODE, which was read. Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 78 be passed to the second reading placed upon final passage and voted on. Discussion was held. Motion carried. A copy of Bill No. 78 was made available for public inspection prior to this meeting by being posted at City Hall on November 22, 2019. The following vote was taken. Ayes:

#### BILL NO. 79

Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Briggs that Bill No. 79 be introduced, AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI ESTABLISHING A LODGING TAX OF FIVE PERCENT (5%) AND SUBMITTING TO THE VOTERS THE SAME PURSUANT TO SECTION 67.1000, which was read. Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 79 be passed to the second reading placed upon final passage and voted on. Discussion was held. Motion carried. A copy of Bill No. 79 was made available for public inspection prior to this meeting by being posted at City Hall on November 22, 2019. The following vote was taken. Ayes: Briggs, Brewer, Chumbley, Mlika and Crawford. Absent: Fisher, Smith and Dolan. Said bill was declared duly passed, numbered Ordinance No. 2019-79, signed and approved by the Mayor and attested by the City Clerk.

#### BILL NO. 80

Motion by Councilmember Briggs second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 80 be introduced, AN ORDINANCE CALLING FOR, AUTHORIZING, ORDERING AND APPROVING A GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI, ON TUESDAY, APRIL 7, 2020, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING ONE CITY COUNCILMAN FROM EACH OF THE FOUR WARDS OF THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI, FOR A REGULAR TERM OF 2 YEARS, DESIGNATING THE TIME OF HOLDING OF SAID ELECTION; AND PROVIDING FOR THE TIME FOR FILING OF CERTIFICATES OF NOMINATION, which was read. Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 80 be passed to the second reading placed upon final passage and voted on. Discussion was held. Motion carried. A copy of Bill No. 80 was made available for public inspection prior to this meeting by being posted at City Hall on November 22, 2019. The following vote was taken. Ayes: Brewer, Chumbley, Mlika, Crawford and Briggs. Absent: Fisher, Smith and Dolan. Said bill was declared duly passed, numbered Ordinance No. 2019-80, signed and approved by the Mayor and attested by the City Clerk.

#### NEW BUSINESS

Motion by Councilmember Mlika second by Councilmember Crawford to approve the cost of the health insurance rates between the City and the employees. Motion carried.

Motion by Councilmember Chumbley second by Councilmember Brewer to accept the only bid for sand received from Norris Quarries for \$8.25 per ton picked up at the plant. Motion carried.

Motion by Councilmember Briggs second by Councilmember Brewer to accept the only bid for rock received from Norris Quarries for \$16.50 per ton picked up at the quarry. Motion carried.

Discussion was held concerning the hay bid at the trap & skeet range. It was discussed about having that area farmed. Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Briggs to reject the bids for haying around the trap and skeet range. Motion carried with Councilmember Briggs voting no.

City Administrator Urton said there were no bids for removal of snow on sidewalks on bridges.

Discussion was held concerning the bay door bids at the street department. We only received one bid from CSI OHD for \$5,200.00 for 2 doors. Motion by Councilmember Mlika second by Councilmember Crawford to accept the bid for 2 bay doors from CSI OHD for \$5,200.00. Motion carried.

Discussion was held concerning the policy for specialty signs. Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Briggs to table this and send it back to the administrative committee. Motion carried.

No action was taken on the tourist brochure.

Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika to approve the City Attorney revising the ordinance for bed and breakfast annual inspection for \$50.00. Motion carried.

Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika meeting adjourned at 8:18 p.m. Motion carried.
