PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE AND PRAYER

MINUTES

Motion by Councilmember Brewer second by Councilmember Briggs that the minutes of March 8, 2021 be approved. Motion carried.

BILLS

Motion by Councilmember Briggs second by Councilmember Brewer that all duly obligated bills for the City be paid. Motion carried.

REPORTS

Reports were given by Councilmember Smith, Councilmember Mlika, Councilmember Humphreys and City Administrator Urton.

BILL NO. 7

Motion by Councilmember Smith second by Councilmember Briggs that Bill No. 7 be introduced, AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI FOR FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2021 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2022 WITH SAID BUDGET FIXING EMPLOYEE AND OFFICER POSITIONS AND COMPENSATION FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR FOR THE SAME AND AUTHORIZING EQUIPMENT PURCHASES, which was read. Motion by Councilmember Smith second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 7 be passed to the second reading placed upon final passage and voted on. Motion carried. A copy of Bill No. 7 was made available for public inspection prior to this meeting by being posted at City Hall on March 19, 2021. The following vote was taken. Ayes: Smith, Mlika, Urich, Dolan, Briggs, Klinginsmith, Brewer and Humphreys. Said bill was declared duly passed, numbered Ordinance No. 2021-7, signed by the Mayor and attested by the City Clerk.

BILL NO. 8

Motion by Councilmember Smith second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 8 be introduced, AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE TRENTON MUNICIPAL UTILITIES, FOR FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2021 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2022 WITH SAID BUDGET FIXING EMPLOYEE AND OFFICER POSITIONS AND COMPENSATION FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR FOR THE SAME AND AUTHORIZING EQUIPMENT PURCHASES, which was read. Motion by Councilmember Smith second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 8 be passed to the second reading placed upon final passage and voted on. Motion carried. A copy of Bill No. 8 was made available for public inspection prior to this meeting by being posted at City Hall on March 19, 2021. The following vote was taken. Ayes: Mlika, Urich, Dolan, Briggs, Klinginsmith, Brewer, Humphreys, and Smith. Said bill was declared duly passed, numbered Ordinance No. 2021-8, signed by the Mayor and attested by the City Clerk.

BILL NO. 9

Motion by Councilmember Smith second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 9 be introduced, AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE IV ENTITLED "EXOTIC OR WILD ANIMALS" OF CHAPTER 210 ENTITLED "ANIMALS AND FOUL" OF TITLE II ENTITLED "PUBLIC HEALTH, WELFARE AND SAFETY" OF THE TRENTON CITY CODE which was read. Motion by Councilmember Smith second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 9 be passed to the second reading placed upon final passage and voted on. Discussion was held. Motion carried. A copy of Bill No. 9 was made available for public inspection prior to this meeting by being posted at City Hall on March 19, 2021. The following vote was taken. Ayes: Urich, Dolan, Briggs, Klinginsmith, Brewer, Humphreys, Smith, and Mlika. Said bill was declared duly passed, numbered Ordinance No. 2021-9, signed by the Mayor and attested by the City Clerk.

NEW BUSINESS

City Administrator Urton said we received 5 bids for the north sub-station fencing. The low bid was from Challenger Fencing for \$47,260.00. Motion by Councilmember Smith second by Councilmember Mlika to accept the bid from Challenger Fencing for \$47,260.00 for the north sub-station fencing. Motion carried.

City Administrator Urton said we received 1 bid for the water plant front steps. Motion by Councilmember Brewer second by Councilmember Briggs to accept the bid from JD Bishop Const. for \$15,145.00 for water plant front step replacement. Motion carried.

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Discussion was held concerning the airport hangar rehabilitation for the north hangars. We need to place asphalt in 3 or 4 hangars for a cost of \$3,000. Motion by Councilmember Briggs second by Councilmember Brewer to repair 3 or 4 hangar floors for \$3,000. Motion carried.

Motion by Councilmember Brewer second by Councilmember Briggs meeting adjourned at 7:30 p.m. Motion carried.
