The Mayor and City Council met in open session, Monday, February 22, 2021 at City Hall at 7:00 p.m. The following officers and members were present: Mayor Linda Crooks-via audio conferencing; Council members Glen Briggs, Danny Brewer, Marvin Humphreys, Cathie Smith, David Mlika, Duane Urich-via audio conferencing and John Dolan-via audio conferencing; City Attorney, Tara Walker-via audio conferencing; City Administrator, Ron Urton; Police Chief, Rex Ross-via audio conferencing and City Clerk, Cindy Simpson. Absent: Kevin Klinginsmith.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE AND PRAYER

At this time, the Pledge of Allegiance was recited. A prayer followed the pledge.

MINUTES

Motion by Councilmember Mlika second by Councilmember Briggs that the minutes of February 8, 2021 be approved. Motion carried.

BILLS

Motion by Councilmember Mlika second by Councilmember Smith that all duly obligated bills for the City be paid. Motion carried.

REPORTS

Councilmember Smith reported on the Utility committee meeting, Councilmember Dolan reported on the finance committee meeting, City Administrator Urton reported on the 28,000 gallons of fuel and oil that was used for the generation.

BILL NO. 4

Motion by Councilmember Smith second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 4 be introduced, AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI APPROVING AN AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI AND MODOT ACCEPTING RIGHT-OF-WAY PER THE JULY 22, 2019 AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF TRENTON AND MODOT IN THE CITY OF TRENTON AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK OF THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI, TO EXECUTE THE SAME BY AND ON BEHALF OF SAID CITY, which was read. Motion by Councilmember Smith second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 4 be passed to the second reading placed upon final passage and voted on. Discussion was held concerning the condition of the newly paved roads by MODOT. Motion by Councilmember Briggs second by Councilmember Mlika to table Bill No. 4. Motion carried.

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-1

Motion by Councilmember Smith second by Councilmember Mlika that Resolution No. 2021-1 be introduced, A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TRENTON, GRUNDY COUNTY, MISSOURI ADOPTING THE GRUNDY COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN, which was read. Motion by Councilmember Smith second by Councilmember Mlika that Resolution No. 2021-1 be passed for adoption. Motion carried. A copy of Resolution No. 2021-1 was made available for public inspection prior to this meeting by being posted at City Hall on February 19, 2021. The following vote was taken. Ayes: Dolan, Briggs, Brewer, Humphreys, Smith, Mlika and Urich. Absent: Klinginsmith. Said resolution was declared duly passed, numbered Resolution No. 2021-1, signed and approved by the Mayor and attested by the City Clerk.

NEW BUSINESS

City Administrator Urton discussed the new meter reading equipment bids. The committee is recommending Anixter/Tantalus. Motion by Councilmember Smith second by Councilmember Briggs to accept the bid from Anixter/Tantalus for meter reading equipment. Motion carried.

City Administrator Humphreys said he does not feel we should be spraying mosquito insecticide in the air for people to breath. It was agreed that the public wants this done.

City Administrator Urton said we have about \$10,000 left in the cares money for the airport and we are needing a mower. The state bid is \$9,700-\$9,800 for a new mower on the state bid. It is a grasshopper mower and we will be purchasing it locally.

Motion by Councilmember Humphreys second by Councilmember Briggs to purchase the mower for the airport with the cares money. Motion carried.

Motion by Councilmember Smith second by Councilmember Brewer to adjourn at 7:32 p.m. to closed session for legal in accordance with RSMo. 610.021(1). The following vote was taken. Ayes: Briggs, Brewer, Humphreys, Smith, Mlika, Urich and Dolan. Absent: Klinginsmith.
