NEW BUSINESS

There is additions for new construction and new subdivision for the sanitary sewer and new construction, new subdivisions and properties with water meters inside buildings for the policy for water service connections. Discussion was held concerning the ambulance rent at the fire station. It was agreed to have the commissioners come back to the January meeting to discuss this.
