BILL NO. 19

Motion by Councilmember Brewer second by Councilmember Otto that Bill No. 19 be introduced, AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI APPROVING A UTILITY AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI AND TRENTON MUNICIPAL UTILITIES TO RELOCATE OVERHEAD POWERLINES TO UNDERGROUND AND TO RELOCATE SEWER LINES AS PART OF THE PAVE TAXILANES AND GRADE T-HANGAR SITE PROJECT AT THE TRENTON MUNICIPAL AIRPORT BETWEEN THE CITY OF TRENTON AND DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION IN THE CITY OF TRENTON AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK OF TE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI TO EXECUTE THE SAME BY AND ON BEHALF OF SAID CITY, which was read. Motion by Councilmember Brewer second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 19 be passed to the second reading placed upon final passage and voted on. Motion Carried. A copy of Bill No. 19 was made available for public inspection prior to this meeting by being posted at City Hall on April 23, 2019. The

following vote was taken. Ayes: Otto, Urich, Brewer, Humphreys, Romesburg, Mlika, Dolan. Absent: Klinginsmith. Said bill was declared duly passed, numbered ordinance 2021-19, signed and approved by the Mayor and attested by the Clerk.

Representatives from TDIA/Main Street Trenton were present to discuss the placement of a memorial bench in downtown Trenton in honor of Elvin Noel.

Discussion was held concerning the proposed 2020-2021 budget adjustments. Motion by Councilmember Humphreys, second by Councilmember Brewer that the budget adjustments be approved as presented. Motion carried.
