### PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE AND PRAYER

At this time the Pledge of Allegiance was recited by everyone present. A prayer followed the pledge.

### MINUTES

Motion by Councilmember Chumbley second by Councilmember Crawford that the minutes of August 26, 2019 be approved. Motion carried.

### BILLS

Motion by Councilmember Chumbley second by Councilmember Crawford that all duly obligated bills for the City be paid. Motion carried.

### REPORTS

Reports were given by Councilmember Crawford, Councilmember Smith, Councilmember Briggs, Councilmember Chumbley and City Administrator Urton.

Connie Ford from MOPEP was present to give the city a grant award of \$95,866.00 for improvements to the electrical system.

### BILL NO. 68

Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 68 be introduced, AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI APPROVING A CONTRACT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI AND TROYER ROOFING AND COATINGS FOR THE METAL ROOF RESTORATION OF THE TRENTON MUNICIPAL UTILITIES WAREHOUSE IN THE CITY OF TRENTON AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK OF THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI, TO EXECUTE THE SAME BY AND ON BEHALF OF SAID CITY, which was read. Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 69 be introduced, AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI APPROVING A CONTRACT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI AND SMI-CO CONTRACTING GROUP, LLC FOR LABOR FOR THE CITY'S LIFT STATION PROJECT IN THE CITY OF TRENTON AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK OF THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI, TO EXECUTE THE SAME BY AND ON BEHALF OF SAID CITY, which was read. Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 69 be passed to the second reading placed upon final passage and voted on. Discussion was held. Motion carried. #### BILL NO. 70

Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 70 be introduced, AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI APPROVING A CONTRACT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI AND ENVIRO-LINE CO. INC. FOR LIFT STATION MATERIALS IN THE CITY OF TRENTON AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK OF THE CITY OF TRENTON, MISSOURI, TO EXECUTE THE SAME BY AND ON BEHALF OF SAID CITY, which was read. Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika that Bill No. 70 be passed to the second reading placed upon final passage and voted on. Discussion was held. Motion carried. A copy of Bill No. 70 was made available for public inspection prior to this meeting by being posted at City Hall on September 6, 2019. The following vote was taken. Ayes: Brewer, Chumbley, Smith, Mlika, Crawford, Dolan, Briggs and Fisher. Said bill was declared duly passed, numbered Ordinance No. 2019-70, signed and approved by the Mayor and attested by the City Clerk.

#### UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Discussion was held concerning a meeting with the county commissioners to discuss projects that the City and County can partner with.

NEW BUSINESS

Discussion was held concerning the 17<sup>th</sup> street bridge bids. The low bid is Boone Construction for \$2,339,736.76.

Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Chumbley to go with Boone Construction bid for the 17<sup>th</sup> street project for \$2,339,736.76. Motion carried.

Bids were taken for diesel fuel for the generators. MFA Oil and Landes Oil both bid \$2.049 per gallon.

Motion by Councilmember Mlika second by Councilmember Chumbley to buy 1 tanker load from each company. Motion carried.

City Administrator Urton said we only received one bid for tree trimming from Asplundh. A 2 man crew would be \$119.21 and a 3 man crew is \$164.79.

Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Brewer to accept the bid from Asplundh for a 2 man crew not to exceed \$25,000.00. Motion carried.

Motion by Councilmember Crawford second by Councilmember Mlika meeting adjourned at 7:48 p.m. Motion carried.
