### PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE AND PRAYER

### MINUTES

### BILLS

### REPORTS

Reports were given by Councilmember Mlika and City Administrator Urton.

### UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Councilmember Humphreys asked about the Verizon Tower. City Administrator Urton said they withdrew that.

Councilmember Humphreys asked how the refinancing for the 17<sup>th</sup> street bridge, sewer and water systems is going. City Administrator Urton said that is done.

Councilmember Humphreys asked how the 28<sup>th</sup> street bridge MOU with the county is going. Ron said it has been delivered but he has not met with them yet.

Councilmember Humphreys asked about the porta pottys that Duane Urich is wanting to purchase. City Administrator Urton said the only one that has responded is TDIA.

Councilmember Brewer feels like if an employee has Covid the City needs to make sure their insurance is paid.

Motion by Councilmember Brewer second by Councilmember Humphreys if an employee gets Covid, with a doctor's excuse, the City should work with the employee and make sure they don't lose their health insurance for up to 60 days. Motion carried.
