UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Jim Watje was present to answer questions about the trash pickup. It was decided that Rapid Removal will write a letter telling customers that they will only pickup 1 bulky item per week and if they leave trash they will leave a note stating why they did not pickup all the trash. The letter will be put in with customers TMU bills.

NEW BUSINESS
